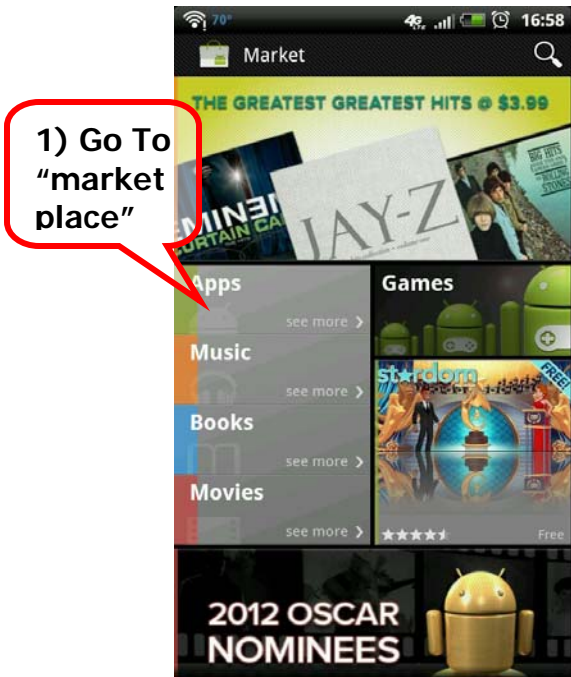

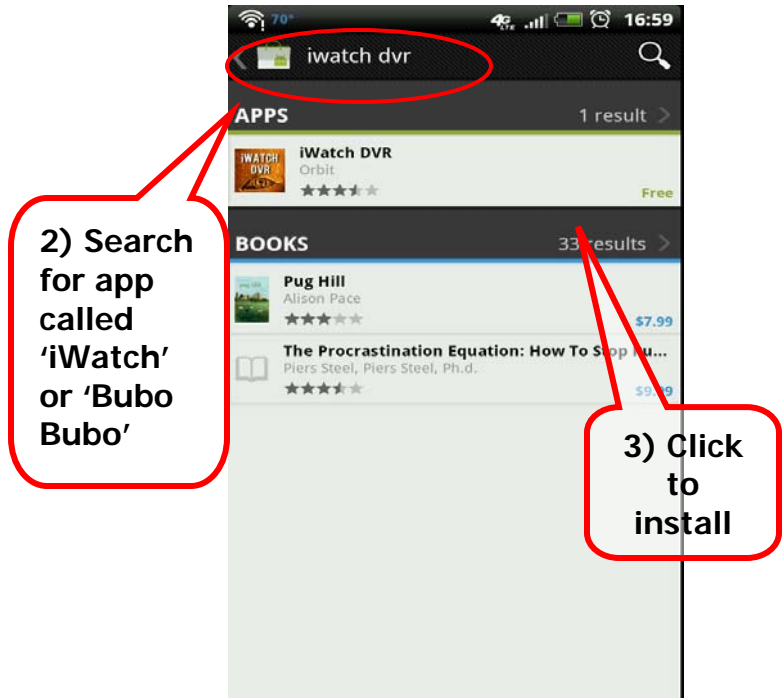

Completing above DVR information (Fig. 3)

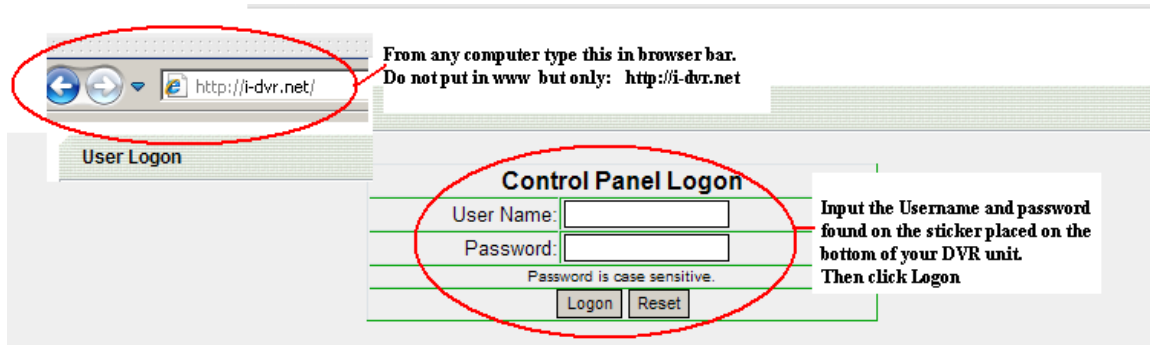
- DVR Name: Any nickname you want to call your DVR (ex. ID View Demo DVR)
- Host: IP Address of DVR or DDNS server site (ex.66.180.119.123 or idview.i-dvr.net)
- Port: Port number DVR is set on (ex.500)
- Username/password: The username and password to log into DVR (default: admin/123456)

i-dvr.net DDNS SETUP

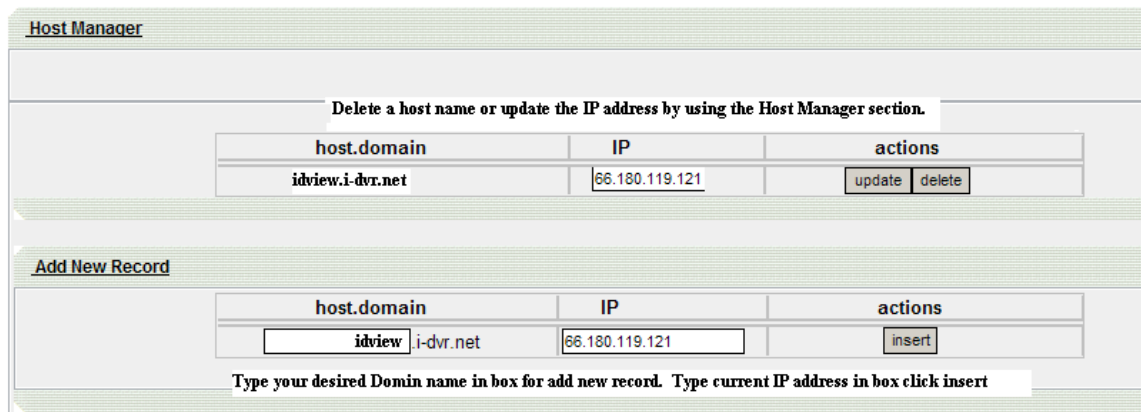
Congratulations on your purchase of an ECO series DVR from Digital IDView.

This unit supports multiple DDNS servers including two servers maintained by us.

On the bottom of your DVR is a user name and password for the i-dvr.net server. I



After putting in the user name and password click on Logon and you will see this screen:



In the DDNS setup (go to menu/main menu/network setup) input information and put a check in the enable DDNS box. Click OK and you are done.
